Setting Up for Success Systems and Procedures

School Hours

School Starts at 8:55 am and finishes at 2:55 pm.

- The school gates open from 8:15 am and close at 3:15 pm. Outside of these times, the school cannot provide care and supervision.
- The best time for children to arrive at school is 8:30am, as the playground is supervised and teachers are in their classrooms.

Exiting School

Junior children must be accompanied by a senior sibling or a parent/caregiver. For safety reasons, they will not be allowed to leave the school on their own.

<u>Uniform</u>

Correct uniform must be worn every day. All school uniform items can be purchased from our school office. The STORE on our school website allows pre-ordering and payment. A reminder that school hats are compulsory in Terms 1 and 4.

<u>Communication</u>

Newsletters, Seesaw, Email, Phone and Facebook (Gate Pā School-Pukehinahina) are all essential tools for staying up-todate with school events and your child(rens) learning.

Contact Details

Please ensure that the office has your most up-to-date contact details. It is vital we can contact you, should an emergency occur.

Parking

The safest place to park is in the neighbouring church car park. This area is available to whānau before and after school. Please do not park in the staff car park.

If you need to take your child out of school early, please sign them out via the office.

If your child is late, they need to enter via the school office so their attendance can be recorded.
