- <u>Get Involved</u> stay connected with the classroom teacher and through our school Facebook. Share your views, skills and talents. Attend school events and support with class trips and special activities whenever you can i.e. Garden to Table, sports coaching and managing...
- <u>Arrival and Leaving School</u> the best time to arrive is from 8:30am as this is when supervision is available. School finishes at 2:55pm. We have a growing number of children still at school well after this time. This puts pressure on our staff. Please be prompt with pick-up.
- <u>Attendance</u> if children attend school daily they will be happier and learn more. If your child does have to be away, please let the office know. This saves us using valuable resources to chase up unexplained absences.

- <u>Correct Uniform</u> make sure your tamariki are in correct uniform every day black bottoms and school polo shirt.
